# ABOUT THE PROGRAM

In the tradition of expanding students' experience and knowledge within the scope of higher education, Woosong University (WSU) actively engages in study abroad programs for undergraduate students with many partner universities. This document is meant to serve as a guide for students interested in applying for exchange programs and study abroad programs. In this document, students can find definitions, requirements, and obligations of WSU Outbound programs.



# PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS & PROCEDURE

The outbound student exchange program provides WSU student with the opportunity to study for one or two semesters at a partner university and transfer credits back to WSU. With many institutions in numerous countries, students have plenty of choices for selecting a host university. In order to qualify to participate in the program, WSU students must fulfill the criteria set by WSU and the host university.

Generally, students who go on exchange pay tuition to WSU. They are not required to pay tuition or enrollment fees to the host university, but they do pay other expenses such as residence, activity fees, medical insurance, flight, etc. to the host university. In some instances, however, the agreement between WSU and the host university may require students to pay tuition (and other cost) to the host university in which case they are treated as Study Abroad student.

Students are advised to consult with the Study Abroad Office about the payment terms before selecting a host university.



# REQUIREMENT

In order to apply for outbound exchange programs, students must meet the following WSU criteria:

Completion of 2 regular semesters at Woosong University


- Students should also ensure that they meet the host university's application requirement.

If students do not meet the minimum credits requirement at the time of application, they are still eligible to apply for exchange as long as they are able to complete the required minimum BEFORE the start of the semester at the host university.



# REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Submit Outbound Program Application Form by the deadline along with other documents
  - Woosong English Transcript
  - Submit minimum IELTS 6.0, TOEFL ibt 60, TOEIC 605, DUOLINGO 95 test result
  - Copy of passport ID page and ARC (international students only)
  - A reference letter from a Professor

# NEXT PROCEDURE

If you successfully pass all the WSU requirements above, you will be asked to fill out application form of the host university.

Submit all forms and supporting documents to the Study Abroad Office for sending to the host university.

While waiting, you can find out about the procedure and processing times for visa of the host country.

Also, make arrangements for your housing, pay any advance fees required by Host University (visa deposit, dorm deposit, etc.) and complete an online registration of courses at the host university, if applicable.

Submit your visa application and make necessary travel arrangements keeping in mind the orientation and semester start dates at the host university.

From this point on, you can start communicating directly with the host university.

- ✘ **If you're planning to do an exchange in your last semester of study**
- ✘ **If you're thinking to go to your own home country as a destination**
- ✘ **If your Head of Dept., Academic Affairs and Study Abroad Office do not approve**
- ✘ **If you're currently on academic leave**

# OBLIGATIONS



- 1.** While studying at the host university, students must comply with the host university's rules and regulations, and students are subject to the host university's disciplinary actions as described in the Student Code of Conduct. In addition, students will be liable for any damages caused by them to the host university's property. The same applies to the host country's laws. Students may be expelled from the host university or have their visa revoked by breaking the host country's laws or the host university's rules.
- 2.** Students are responsible for their non-tuition expenses. This includes books, residence, flight or other cost which they may incur while studying at the host institution. WSU is under no obligation to provide financial support to student to cover nontuition expenses.
- 3.** Students are responsible for applying for and obtaining visas to exit Korea and enter the host country. The Study Abroad Office will offer general guidance and provide official documentation if necessary but will not be held liable if a student's visa application is rejected or if a student is unable to obtain a visa on time.
- 4.** Students must settle their WSU tuition for the respective semester before leaving for the exchange program.

**1. Can I go on exchange to a university that does not have an agreement with WSU?**

No, credits are not transferrable without an agreement.

**2. Can I register for any course of my choice at the host university if I cannot register for the courses listed on my learning agreement?**

You must get approval from the Study Abroad office and your Head of Department before making changes. Otherwise, you might face difficulty with credit transfer.

**3. Can I submit TOEFL instead of IELTS or other English scores?**

Generally, yes, unless TOEFL is specifically required by the partner university.

**4. Can I still go on exchange if none of the courses count towards my graduation?**

Yes, but be aware that if you insist on going, your graduation will most likely be delayed.

**5. Can I withdraw from a program after being accepted?**

Yes, but you must submit the withdrawal form to receive official approval from the Study Abroad office, and you will not have any chances to apply for the exchange program again. We strongly recommend that you do not apply unless you are sure of going abroad.

**6. During an exchange, if I fail in only one course, can I still maintain my scholarship?**

An "F" grade in any one course will affect your scholarship and your transcript will be recorded as "FAIL" . Please consult with the WSU Academic Affairs for further information.

**7. My alien registration card will expire during my semester abroad, can I still go?**

Yes, but you have to renew your alien registration before you leave Korea.

**8. I am in my 8th semester and still need to take one more semester to graduate. Can I apply to go on exchange in my final semester which will be my 9th semester?**

No, students cannot go abroad in their 9th semester(Bachelor's degree) or 5th semester(Masters degree).

**9. I have been on exchange twice. Can I apply to go on exchange a third time?**

No, student can go on exchange only for two semesters (i.e., twice).

**10. I am not sure which exchange program would be best for me. What advice/resources are available to help students select a school?**

The university you select will depend on what criteria is most important to you. You may consider making your selection based on factors such as the reputation of the school, programs available, program cost, cultural experience. We advise students to attend our information sessions to get a better idea of the options available to them and how to select schools.

**11. I'm a Master's student at Woosong University, can I join the Exchange Program?**

Not all agreements between universities extend to the graduate programs due to the length of the study being short. So, if you're a graduate student who's interested in the exchange program, please contact us for a consultation.

**12. Can I do an online exchange program?**

No. All exchange programs require you to be physically in the host country regardless their classes are online/ offline.

**13. I'm currently on academic leave, can I go for exchange next semester?**

No. You have to go back to a regular semester first at WSU then apply for exchange after you're back from your leave.
