2. Eligibility for Admissions

A. Master's Degree program(Freshmen)

- 1) Applicants who have received a graduation certificate and an undergraduate degree from a four-year university (including those who are expected to obtain a graduation certificate and an undergraduate degree in August 2026)
- 2) Applicants whose qualifications are recognized by law (as equivalent or higher academic qualifications)

B. Ph.D. program(Freshmen)

- 1) Applicants who have earned a Master's degree from graduate schools (including those who are expected to obtain a Master's degree in August 2026)
- 1) Applicants whose qualifications are recognized by law (as equivalent or higher academic qualifications)

C. Integrated Master's and Ph.D. Program

- 1) Applicants who have obtained a bachelor's degree from a four-year university (including those expected to graduate by August 2026)
- 2) Applicants whose qualifications are recognized by law (as equivalent or higher academic qualifications)

D. Requirements for International Students

- ※ The applicant and both parents must hold non-Korean citizenship
- ※ Overseas citizens who have completed all of the educational programs including primary, secondary education, and higher education
- ※ Tuition for freshman (international students) must be paid in U.S. dollars (USD). For online degree programs, all tuition payments must be made in USD until graduation.
- ※ Application submission: <https://apply.wsu.ac.kr/apply> or in person at Graduate School Administration Office (Woosong Hall, W7, 1st Floor).
- ※ Successful applicants must apply for the Certificate of Admission for visa issuance. Failure to apply may result in cancellation of admission.
- ※ Original copies of the bank statement and degree certificate verification (issued by a national authority of the student's home country) must be submitted.

E. Research Programs : Refer to Master's Degree program (Only for Korean Students)

F. Eligibility to apply for academic-research cooperative program selection (Only for Korean Students)

- Applicants who have obtained (or are expected to obtain by August 2026) a bachelor's degree in Korea or abroad, or those whose qualifications are recognized by law (as equivalent or higher academic qualifications)

2) Selection and Restrictions

- a) Successful applicants are selected based on the combined evaluation of document evaluation and interview results, ranked in order of total score.
- b) If 2/3 of committee members grade applicant's documents as D (fail) in the documents evaluation and interview, those applicants will not pass admission evaluation.

3) Evaluation Process for applicants with the same scores

- a) Priority will be given to applicants with higher scores in document and interview evaluations.
- b) Priority will be given to those who submitted documents first.
- ※ For Ph.D. in AI Management Hospitality and Tourism Management, Management Studies, International Education Management, Integrated Master's and Ph.D. Program interview will be conducted separately.

2) Eligibility for the Special Admission

- a) Applicants with at least 18 months of work experience in an industrial enterprise, research institute, educational institution, or public organization.
 - ※ The working period is calculated after high school graduation and includes working period while attending university.
 - ※ Only periods covered by National Health Insurance or National Pension enrollment are recognized.
- b) Professional Engineers (Architectures), Certified Public Accountants, Attorneys, or Master's degree holders.
- c) Applicants who have obtained a bachelor's degree from a country where English is the official language.

3) Eligibility for the General Admission

Applicants who meet the general admission requirements but do not fall under the Special Admission.

4) Selection and Restrictions

- a) Priority is given to applicants eligible under the Special Admission.
- b) Successful applicants are selected based on the combined evaluation of document evaluation and interview results, ranked in order of total score.
- c) If 2/3 of committee members grade applicant's documents as D (fail) in the documents evaluation and interview, those applicants will not pass admission evaluation.

5) Screening Process for applicants with the same scores

- a) Priority will be given to applicants with higher cumulative undergraduate GPAs, followed by higher interview scores.
- b) Priority will be given to applicants with higher scores in interview evaluations.

C. Research Program(Only for Korean Students)

- 1) The evaluation criteria for the Research Program are the same as the Master's Program.
 - 2) If 2/3 of committee members grade applicant's documents as D (fail) in the documents evaluation and interview, those applicants will not pass admission evaluation.
 - 3) Applicants for Master's Degree, who have been selected for the Admission Process but got cancelled/rejected, will be admitted to the Research Program if they choose Research Program as their second preference.
- ※ For Master's programs in Foodservice and Restaurant Entrepreneurship Major and Department of Techno-Media Convergence, interview will be conducted separately.

4. Required documents for application

A. Master's Degree Program / Integrated Master's and Ph.D. Program

- 1) Admission application form – 1 copy
- 2) Official College/University Diploma (or Expected Graduation Certificate), Official College/University transcript – 1 copy each
 - For applicants who graduated from universities in China: Official graduation certificate and Chinese Higher Education Qualification Verification (CHSI) (1 copy each)
 - For applicants who graduated from overseas universities, copy of College/University Diploma with apostille is required (1 copy)
- 3) Research Proposal – 1 copy
- 4) Certificate of Employment (if applicable for applicants employed by companies, research institutes, or public organizations) – 1 copy
- 5) Proof of Language Proficiency (for international students)
 - ▶ Minimum required scores: TOPIK Level 3, IELTS 5.5, or Duolingo English Test 85 ~ 90
 - ▶ The test result must be valid through the application process
- 6) Copy of Passport (for international students)
- 7) National Insurance Enrollment Certificate – for applicants applying for Industrial Employees Scholarships

B. Ph.D. Program

- 1) Admission application form – 1 copy
- 2) Official College/University Diploma (or Expected Graduation Certificate), Official College/University transcript – 1 copy each
 - For applicants who graduated from universities in China: Official graduation certificate and Chinese Higher Education Qualification Verification (CHSI) (1 copy each)
 - For applicants who graduated from overseas universities, copy of College/University Diploma with apostille is required (1 copy)
- 3) Research Proposal (Designated Graduate School Form) – 1 copy
- 4) Proof of Language Proficiency (for international students)
 - ▶ Minimum required scores: TOPIK Level 4, IELTS 6.0, or Duolingo English Test 95-100
 - ▶ The test result must be valid through the application process
- 5) Copy of Passport (for international students)
- 6) Certificate of Employment and Certificate of National Insurance Enrollment – 1 copy each (required only for applicants applying for Industrial Employees Scholarships)

※ Original copies of the College/University Diploma (Expected Graduation Certificate) and Official Transcript (covering all academic years) must be submitted.

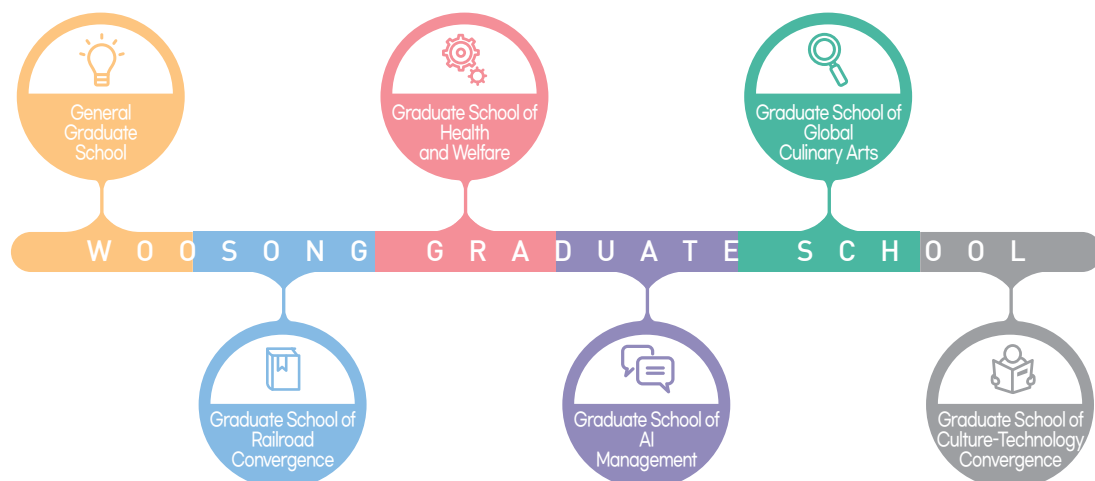
※ Mailed applications will be accepted only if they arrive by the deadline; applications with missing documents or unpaid application fees will not be accepted.

Scholarships and Benefits

1. Academic Excellence Scholarship:
 - Students whose undergraduate major aligns with their graduate major and who have achieved a GPA of 3.50 or higher (on a 4.50 scale) in their 3rd and 4th years are eligible for this scholarship (Applicable for Master's Degree only)
 - Prospective bachelor graduates will be evaluated based on their GPA as of the application submission date.
 - Tuition Reduction: 50% for general graduate schools, 30% for special graduate schools.
2. Full-time faculty, staff (including teaching assistants), and their children or spouses are eligible for a 50% Tuition Fee Reduction
3. Teachers whose current or prior teaching field corresponds with their graduate major are eligible for a 50% Tuition Fee Reduction
4. Government officials and Industrial Employees are eligible for a 30% Tuition Fee Reduction
5. International Students Special Scholarship
 - 1st semester: 30% Tuition Fee Reduction,
 - From 2nd semester: Scholarship amounts vary based on academic performance and language proficiency
6. Graduates of Woosong University are exempted from the enrollment fee
7. Students who are employed as research or administrative assistants will receive monthly scholarship.
8. Research Support Scholarship (Full Tuition Fee)
 - ※ Note: Duplicate receipt of internal graduate school scholarships is not permitted.

Benefits of Completing the Master's Program

1. Students have option to graduate without a thesis paper.
2. Students who complete designated coursework at partner institutions abroad may be eligible to receive a dual (joint) master's degree.
3. Special lectures are offered during summer and winter semesters, taught by distinguished international scholars.
4. Customized curriculum available for industry-sponsored students
5. Work-related projects and professional training conducted in industry can be linked to academic coursework.
6. On-job training and internship conducted within industries may be recognized as coursework credits. (Only for Korean students)
